METHODOLOGY

The Treaty Commission was part of an omnibus telephone survey conducted by the Mustel Group February 11-16. The survey of 509 British Columbians has a 95% confidence rating. Accuracy is plus or minus 4.4 per cent, 19 times out of 20.

Q. *Do you believe settling treaties with First Nations will have a positive impact, negative impact, or no real impact on your **local economy**?*

Positive impact	31%
Negative impact	15%
No impact	43%
Don't know	10%

Q. *Do you believe settling treaties with First Nations will have a positive impact, negative impact, or no real impact on the **provincial economy**?*

Positive impact	41%
Negative impact	23%
No impact	24%
Don't know	11%

Q. *Do you believe settling treaties with First Nations will provide social benefits for all British Columbians?*

Yes	34%
No	56%

Q. *Do you believe resolving land claims should be a high priority, medium priority or low priority of government?*

High priority	25%
Medium priority	48%
Low priority	25%
